

Job Opening for a Sanitarian / Environmental Health Inspector – Updated April 13, 2022

The Uncas Health District is currently recruiting for a Sanitarian/Environmental Health Inspector to support our environmental health program. This is a working field professional in environmental health.

Required Qualifications (Minimum) – Bachelor's Degree in Environmental Health, Biology or a closely related field, and two years of increasingly responsible practical environmental health inspection and enforcement experience or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience. Applicants must be a self-motivated, organized individual with the ability to work independently and is a strong team member. A general knowledge of computers is necessary. The individual must possess the ability to work cooperatively and communicate effectively with other staff members, local officials and the public.

Special Requirements – State of Connecticut certification in food service inspections, Subsurface Sewage Disposal Phase I and II and certification as a lead inspector/risk assessor are preferred. The preferred candidate shall work towards and obtain the Registered Environmental Health Specialist (REHS/RS) designation within a mutually agreed upon time frame.
